Pomeroy Philatelic Society

2023 marks the 137th anniversary of Toledo's first stamp club, the Pomeroy Philatelic Society, established May 6th, 1886. Successor clubs were the Toledo Philatelic Society, and present Stamp Collectors Club of Toledo. Pomeroy Philatelic Society was the second club to join American Philatelic Assn. (later American Philatelic Society) later that same year.

WSPD Is On the Air!

On July 21, 1948, Toledo's first television station, Channel 13, flickered to life.

In its infancy, the station focused on community involvement, news and quality entertainment.

The early days set the standard for television technology and innovation.

Originally, the station carried programming from all four television networks: ABC, NBC, CBS and DuMont. However, it was a primary NBC affiliate, owing to its radio sisters' long affiliation with NBC radio. DuMont shut down in 1955, leaving WSPD-TV affiliated with just the big three networks.

In 1964, Channel 13 was the first to broadcast network programs in color.

In the 1970's channel 13 was the first to bring Toledo electronic news gathering with insta-cams. That was followed later by the market's first satellite newsgathering operation.

WTVG operated as an NBC affiliate until 1995 when it became an ABC owned station.

The new brand of 13 ABC quickly became synonymous with quality and innovation. News and public affairs programming was expanded to meet the station's mission of serving the public well throughout Northwest Ohio and Southeast Michigan.



In 2010 13 ABC became Toledo's first station to upgrade to wide screen and then full high definition.

13 ABC also operates digital station's featuring weather information and the CW network. 13 ABC.Com allows users to track the latest news from Toledo and throughout the world. 13 ABC'S top rated local programs get connected to people through social media sites, media sites, mobile applications and text alerts.
